

ANNOUNCES RELOCATION OF OPERATIONS TO LOCKPORT, ILLINOIS



MAGENTA LLC has announced plans to relocate its plastics injection molding manufacturing operations from Chicago to Lockport, Illinois, 30 miles southwest of Chicago in Will County this spring.

The company plans to start moving into its 122,500 square foot Lockport building in April 2016 and have it fully operational by the end of June. MAGENTA, now at 3800 N. Milwaukee Ave., Chicago will assume a former plastics injection molding facility at 15160 New Ave. in Lockport. Various progress photos were recently taken showing construction and remodeling work underway at the Lockport site. This work is expected to continue during February and March.

“MAGENTA’s relocation allows us to take advantage of a facility that was specifically designed for injection molding production and enable us to accommodate our customers more effectively and efficiently,” said CEO Robert Mallo in announcing the relocation of operations to Lockport. He added the plant would be updated with advanced technologies and green initiatives that demonstrate its long-term commitment to the North American plastics industry and an expanding customer base.

New chillers, cooling towers and air compressors




Loading Docks at New Plant
